



NOTIS Translation/Interpretation Conference Scholarship

Purpose: Through its scholarships program, NOTIS aims to support the translation and interpretation community by increasing access to essential training. This scholarship is intended to help NOTIS members attend a translation or interpretation conference of their choosing (either online or in person). Some examples of conferences include [ATA](#), [ALTA](#), [CHIA](#), [NAJIT](#), etc.

Award: The scholarship will be a maximum set amount of \$1000, to cover the cost of conference registration and also offset travel and lodging costs.

Eligibility and Requirements: Applicants must be a member of NOTIS in good standing. Applicants may only apply for one scholarship at a time. Scholarship recipients will pay for their registration cost up front, and upon presentation of their conference registration and a budget for travel and lodging costs, will receive their scholarship amount. After receiving the scholarship, the applicant will write a blog post for NOTIS on their experience at the conference (length of 300-500 words, submitted within 30 days after completion of conference). Candidates will be evaluated anonymously by a committee using a predetermined set of objective criteria.

Deadline: May 4, 2018. (Scholarship recipients will be selected by May 25, 2018.*)
