



NOTIS Translation/Interpretation Tuition Scholarship

Purpose: Through its scholarships program, NOTIS aims to support the translation and interpretation community by increasing access to essential training. This scholarship is intended to help NOTIS members attend a translation or interpretation course or training of their choosing (either online or in person). For some ideas, see the list on the second page.

Award: The scholarship will cover 80% of the successful applicants' tuition costs, with NOTIS paying up to a total of \$750 per scholarship.

Eligibility and Requirements: Applicants must be members of NOTIS in good standing. Applicants may only apply for one scholarship at a time. Scholarship recipients will pay for their tuition up front, and upon presentation of their receipt, will be refunded for 80% of the course's tuition, up to \$750. After receiving the scholarship, the applicant will write a blog post for NOTIS on a subject related to the translation or interpreting profession (length of 300-500 words, submitted within 30 days after completion of coursework). NOTIS trainings are not eligible to be covered by this scholarship. Candidates will be evaluated anonymously by a committee using a predetermined set of objective criteria.

Deadline: May 4, 2018. (Scholarship recipients will be selected by May 25, 2018.)
